Description

The Charleswater Stati-Check™ provides a unique visual method of detecting how much static charge a person is carrying.

The tester can be mounted outside an ESD protected area (EPA) for training and checking purposes. It can also show the effect of grounding the operator. Inside an EPA it can be used to verify that the operator potential is below a desired limit.

Packaging

Remove the test unit from the carton and inspect for shipping damages.

Each <u>99137</u> unit should include the following:

- 1 Stati-Check™ Personnel Static Charge Visualiser meter
- 1 Ground Cord
- 1 Battery

The meter must always be grounded, to produce an accurate measurement, but more importantly to allow the operator to discharge to a safe handling limit. Touch to test,

and watch the liquid crystal display indicate between 0 to ±5,000 Volt. The unit remains permanently switched on with a battery life of 6 months. Calibration is recommended every 12 months.
