Balance Alarm Programmer Operating Instructions





62201(ZVI-BAP) Balance Alarm Programmer

Remove the 62201(ZVI-BAP) from the carton and inspect for damage. Included with the unit should be:

- 1. EN606W2 Data Cable
- 2. 9 Volt Battery

Setting The Balance Alarm

The 62213(ZVI5100) ships with the balance alarm sensitivity set to ± 20 Volts. Alarm sensitivities of ± 5 Volts, ± 10 Volts, ± 15 Volts, ± 20 Volts, ± 25 Volts, or "NO ALARM" can be set using the 62201(ZVI-BAP).

With The 62213(ZVI5100) Turned ON:

1. Select the desired alarm sensitivities of ±5 Volts, ±10 Volts, ±15 Volts, ±20 Volts, ±25 Volts, or "**NO ALARM**" on the **62201(ZVI-BAP)**.

2. Plug the data cable into the **RS485** "IN" jack.

3. Turn the **62201(ZVI-BAP) ON** using the rocker switch on the top of the programmer.

4. The LED on the ZVI-BAP will start out steady RED; as the 62201(ZVI-BAP) communicates with the 62213(ZVI5100) the LED will blink RED; when programming is complete the LED will turn to a steady GREEN.

 Unplug the 62201(ZVI-BAP) from the 62213(ZVI5100).
Turn the 62201(ZVI-BAP) OFF using the rocker switch on the top of the programmer.
